

Trade flow in 2008 – Estimates per February 2011








EU imports of bamboo and rattan

Annot into the EU of Bamboo and Rattan furniture : trend





- HS: Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System, developed by World Customs Organization
- comprises about 5,000 commodity groups; each identified by a <u>six digit</u> code.
- Implemented in 1988 and updated in 1992, 1996, 2002, 2007 and in 2012.
- Used by more than 200 countries: 98 % of the merchandise in international trade is classified in terms of the HS.
- Difference in number of codes (product categories) for bamboo in HS2002 and HS 2007 – but no further additions for Bamboo and Rattan in 2012.



HS2002 codes : Total of 9 codes:

- 1- for bamboo for plaiting
- 1- for rattan for plaiting
- 7 for <u>mixed</u> products with bamboo and similar materials

HS2007 codes : Total of 16 codes (remained same under HS2012)

- 2- 'old' for bamboo for plaiting and rattan for plaiting
- 2- for new for bamboo and rattan furniture and seats
- 9 -new for bamboo
- 3-new for rattan

The approval of new codes reflects increasing trade of bamboo products.

A new code will be added if it will collect a **minimum of 50 M US\$** annual trade value.

The data can now be more precise.

<u>33 National 8-digit codes for bamboo in China (as of 2011)</u>: **Most of these correlate to HS Codes, some do not**

- 1 for bamboo for plaiting;
- 4 for bamboo plaited products;
- 12 for bamboo panels;
- 1 for bamboo charcoal;
- •2 for bamboo chopsticks and kitchenware;
- 1 for bamboo sticks;
- 1 for bamboo pulp;
- 1 for bamboo paper articles;
- •3 for bamboo fiber products;
- 1 for bamboo sculpture;
- 4 for bamboo shoots;
- •2 for bamboo and rattan furniture and seats




EU FLEGT and US Lacey Act:

- Bilateral Trade Agreements(FLEGT licensed timber);
- Measures on illegally harvested / traded plant and plant products (Lacey);
- Bamboo and rattan products covered.
- HS codes included which cover B&R products
 - 4402: Bamboo charcoal (FLEGT/Lacey)
 - 4409: Bamboo flooring (FLEGT/Lacey)
 - 4412: Bamboo plywood (FLEGT/Lacey)
 - 4823: Bamboo paper articles(FLEGT)
 - 9401: Seats of bamboo/rattan(FLEGT)
- HS Codes included which also could include B&R products
 - ➢ 4418: Builders' joinery and carpentry.. (FLEGT/Lacey)
 - 4419: Tableware & kitchenware (FLEGT/Lacey)
 - ➢ 4420: Statuettes & other ornaments (FLEGT/Lacey)


INBAR Import into EU of 'chapter 44' products from selected countries

Chapter 44 = WOOD AND ARTICLES OF WOOD; (WOOD) CHARCOAL (EU Trade Statistics)




VPAs: Ghana 2009; Congo 2010; Cameroon 2010; Indonesia 2011; (China N/A)


TINBAR Import in and export from China of chapter 44 products

Rattan raw materials trade and export of B&R furniture



Export raw materials from Indonesia is going up, export going down: loss of traditional export markets due to business environment, lack of investment / upgrading technology or lack of materials for processing in Indonesia? Since January 2012 total export ban.



- Overall global trade trend: due to economic situation major import countries a decline in value, but export from China rising again since 2011;
- Global Trade value of bamboo and rattan expected to increase again, but mostly in new markets in Asia and in domestic emerging markets.
- •Data accuracy also depends on use of latest HS codes;
- Bamboo products are affected by FLEGT and Lacey: will have effect on trade;
- For FLEGT and Lacey to be effective, involvement and sustainable supply chain from all exporting countries essential.
