How do I do it?

- ► Go to the SWST website; click on Publications [http://www.swst.org/publications/wfs/index.html]
- Click on Information for Authors
- When manuscript is in proper format, click on Research Contributions and follow links Wood & Fiber Science Journal [http://wfs.swst.org/index.php/wfs] to submit article

Most common errors

- The manuscript needs to be edited by a fluent English writer. Such services can be found on the internet if required.
- Color reproduction is very expensive. Use grayscale.
- Title page should be done as per journal guidelines on a separate loading page.
- ► Titles such as Professor, Research Scientist, Graduate Research Assistant, etc. should be used instead of degree held (like PhD).
- Names/affiliations of the authors should not be in the Body of the submission to comply with the blind review process.

- ▶ E-mail addresses should be provided for all authors.
- Acknowledgments should be on the separate loading page and not in the manuscript body.
- References and citations (in text) should follow journal guidelines.
- ► For journal abbreviations, see:

 http://www.efm.leeds.ac.uk/~mark/ISIabbr/. If a reference is a non-English paper indicate which language at the end of the reference, eg., (in Chinese)]
- ► The text should be left-justified, single-spaced, paragraphs not indented, and one blank line between paragraphs.

- Line numbers on the left margin should be used. Select Line Numbers under Page Layout in WORD.
- Units and symbols should follow journal guidelines.
- The headings should follow journal guidelines.
- ▶ Figures/tables placement should not be in the text, but should follow References. The publisher will determine placement. A list of figure captions should precede the figures. Figures and Tables should be placed on a separate page and should follow journal guidelines. High resolution TIFF files are preferred for figures.
- Tables should be done in Word format and not pasted as images. Put each Table on a separate page.

- How does WFS select reviewers?
- They are selected by the Editor based on the reviewer's stated expertise area and the editor's knowledge of the reviewer.
- How long before publication?
- ► Most journals range between 6-9 months
- ▶ What are the page charges for *WFS*?
- Members=\$75/page; Non-members=\$150/page
