How would it work?

- 1. SWST will solicit technical assistance needed through web announcements
 - Requirements
 - project should not take more than a month to complete
 - backed by local research organization, leaders, and people directly affected

Memorandum of Understanding

- 2. Interested group of researchers (SWST members) draft a MOU outlining
 - Tasks to be completed
 - Parties involved
 - Financial obligations and assistance needed from SWST
 - Local organizations involved and committed
 - Responsibilities of each group involved
 - Impact of the work
 - Timeline

Approval by SWST

- 3. SWST committee and board will evaluate the proposal
 - o impact
 - obligations
 - duration
 - commitments
 - financial support and obligations
- 4. Decide whether to support & fund

If Approved

- Project will be completed by the group based on MOU established
- Press release outlining the work done, region affected, and impact

Concerns

Financial burden

- fund raising activities
- o contributions from companies, government organizations, UN, foundations (Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, Paul Allen Family Foundation)
- Commitment from the locals
 - crucial that local research organization is committed and involved
- Visas and security
